Thinking Theologically...

There are three ways that we might experience the presence of God and the grace of God, especially in the summertime. Theologians call these ways general, direct, and Divine revelation.

General revelation is accessible to all people through their senses: sight, touch, smell, and experience. General revelation entails our experience of the world and our conviction (or not) that it comes to us as the product of a Creator of surpassing power and influence.

Direct revelation involves coming to the knowledge of God through means beyond normal reason: miracles, visions, dreams, intuitions.

Divine revelation consists of the witness of Scripture, the Old and New Testaments of the Bible.

How might you find moments through these summer weeks to allow God to be revealed more fully in your life?
